sigmund freud evolved his theories throughout his lifetime this entailed many revisions and changes which he himself never tried to standardise rigidly into a definitive conceptual system

the need for some sort of a reliable guide which would spell out both the pattern of the evolution of Freud's thinking as well as establish its inherent logic was felt for a long time by both scholars and students of psychoanalysis. Drs. Laplanche and Pontalis of the Association Psychanalytique de France succeeded admirably in providing a dictionary of Freud's concepts which is more than a compilation of mere definitions.
